RECRUITMENT OF MEMBER OF THE AUDIT COMMITTEE FOR THE NATIONAL TREASURY

A. INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to Section 73(5) and 155(5) of the PFM Act, 2012 and PFM Regulations, 2015, and the guidelines for establishment of Audit Committees in all public entities vide Kenya Gazette Notice Vol. CXVIII No. 40 of 15th April, 2016, The National Treasury is recruiting Member of it's Audit Committee.

B. REQUIREMENTS FOR APPOINTMENT

To be appointed as a Member of the Audit Committee, one must have the following:

1. A Degree from a recognized university;
2. Working experience of not less than five (5) years;
3. Be a member of a professional body and in good standing;
4. Knowledge in Public Service/Government/The National Treasury operations; and
5. Be a person of integrity and in compliance with the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010. Refer to Regulation 174 of the PFM Regulations, 2015 for details.

All interested applicants who meet the above requirements should submit their applications together with a detailed Curriculum Vitae, copies of academic and professional certificates, testimonials and copy of National Identity Card in a sealed envelope addressed to: **The Cabinet Secretary**, The National Treasury.

Former members are eligible to apply.

Deadline for receipt of applications is: **15th April, 2026**

If within one (1) month from the date of the deadline an applicant does not hear from the Ministry, they should consider their application unsuccessful.
