## **PUBLIC STATEMENT ON THE STATUS OF PAYMENTS TO COUNTY GOVERNMENTS**

- This Statement is issued in public interest pursuant to Article 35(3) of the Constitution and section 7 of the County Allocation of Revenue Act (CARA), 2019. The Statement is intended to inform citizens about the quantum of funds transferred to County Governments in FY 2019/20 and in preceding
- By the end of FY 2019/20, County Governments had received Ksh. 286.8 billion from their equitable share of revenue raised nationally, equivalent to 91 percent of the Ksh. 316.5 billion appropriation as per the CARA, 2019. Payments to the Counties are summarized in *Table 1*, while cumulative and per person disbursements to each County are shown in **Table 2**.

th FY 2017/18, FY 2018/19 and FY 2019/20, Ksh. 3.4 billion, Ksh 4.3 billion and Ksh 4.3 billion respectively, from the National Government's revenue share was paid to the National Hospital Insurance Fund (NHIF) as a grant for Free Maternal Healthcare, to be disbursed directly to Counties on reimbursement basis.

- The National Government in FY 2019/20 transferred an additional Ksh. 7.7 billion to the Counties, as part of Covid-19 pandemic emergency response measures. The funding, which was not part of CARA, 2019 allocations comprised of:
  - billion was distributed among Counties using the equitable revenue share distribution formula, for the purpose of setting up requisite infrastructure for urgent response to the pandemic. The balance of Ksh. 2.4 billion was distributed based on recommendations by the Salaries and Renumeration Commission (SRC) for the purpose of supplementing allowances for frontline healthcare workers.
  - Ksh. 350 million from the Royal Danish Embassy: This amount was disbursed through Ministry of Health (MoH).

- The Counties received another Ksh. 43.4 billion in FY 2019/20, which comprised of:
  - conditional allocations worth Ksh. 13.3 billion derived from the National Government's equitable reva) enue share:
  - Ksh. 7.6 billion from the Roads Maintenance Levy Fund (RMLF) collected by the Kenya Roads Board b) (KRB), of which 15 percent is set aside for County roads; and,
  - proceeds from external loans and grants totaling Ksh. 22.4 billion earmarked to supplement financing of devolved functions.
- Excluding the Covid-19 pandemic support, aggregate payments to the Counties relating to FY 2019/20 now amount to Ksh. 330.1 billion, representing 87.2 percent of DoRA, 2019 allocations (i.e. Ksh 378.5 billion). The shortfall may be explained as follows:
  - Incomplete disbursement of FY 2019/20 equitable revenue share to the Counties. This was due to unprecedented shortfalls in ordinary revenue experienced during the last quarter of the financial year as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic, and ensuing Government fiscal measures to cushion affected households and businesses. It should however be noted that on August 5th, 2020, the National Treasury disbursed to the Counties a total of Ksh. 26.2 billion of the outstanding amounts. A breakdown of these disbursements is shown in **Table 3.**
  - Failure by some Counties to adhere to requirements of specific conditional allocations. For this reason, h) the Exchequer could not disburse:
    - Ksh. 617 million for the Water & Sanitation Development Project;

    - Ksh. 338 million for the Transforming Health Systems for Universal Care Project; Ksh. 337 million for the National Agriculture and Rural Inclusive Growth Project (NARIGP);
    - Ksh. 80 million for the Kenya Urban Support Programme (KUSP);
    - Ksh. 385 million for construction of County headquarters; and,
    - Ksh. 1.339 million from the RMLE.
  - Delays by Accounting Officers of some Ministries responsible for specific conditional grants to submit written instructions to the National Treasury to release payments as stipulated in the **Guidelines for** the Management of Intergovernmental Fiscal Transfers (2017). The delays, which stretched into the last quarter of the financial year, significantly undermined overall resource absorption, in turn requiring the National Treasury to remove from the budget an estimated Ksh 14.7 billion worth of unspent conditional grants funded mostly by development partners. The 'cuts' were intended to create room in the FY 2019/20 fiscal framework so as to enable mobilization and reallocation of resources towards the Covid-19 pandemic. Accordingly, the Exchequer could not disburse: Ksh. 4.9 billion for level II grant of the Kenya Devolution Support Program (KDSP); Ksh. 880 million for the Water Tower Protection, Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation Programme (WaTER); and, Ksh. 350 million for the Northern Kenya Drought Resilience Programme.
- Including the FY 2019/20 payments, County Governments have now received an estimated Ksh. 2.038 trillion cumulatively since their establishment. In this context, it would be useful for the public to note that:
  - of the above cumulative payments, 91.2 percent comprises of the unconditional equitable revenue a) share;
  - in all years, County Governments' equitable revenue share has been well above the minimum threshold defined in Article 203(2) of the Constitution, and except for FY 2019/20, the equitable revenue share has been fully disbursed in accordance with Article 219 of the Constitution;
  - during the last seven years, aggregate annual payments to Counties has grown by Ksh. 142.3 billion or c) 73 percent; and,
  - in per capita (or per person) terms, County payments have grown from Ksh. 4,114 in FY 2013/14 to Ksh. 7,103 in FY 2019/20. This translates to an annual average of Ksh. 6,121, with Nairobi receiving the d) least (Ksh. 3,067) and Lamu the highest (Ksh. 17,556).
