- Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines for Procurement of Goods, Works, and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, dated January 2011 ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
- Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the Project Manager, The National Treasury – Financial Sector Support Project and inspect the bidding documents during office hours, Monday to Friday, 0900 to 1630 hours Kenyan Time excluding holidays, at the address given below.
- A complete set of bidding documents in the *English* language may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Kenya Shillings One Thousand (KES 1,000.00)**. The method of payment will be by cash at the Cash Office situated on 7th Floor, Anniversary Towers; North Tower. The bidding document will be obtained from Anniversary Towers, North Tower 7th Floor, University Way during working hours between 0900 hrs and 1630hrs.
- Bids must be delivered to the address below **on or before 16th November 2020 at 1200 hours local time**. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened immediately thereafter in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who may choose to attend at the address below.
