

Government, civil society agree on joint digitization awareness campaign

he Government and the civil society have agreed to a joint public constitution comparison on sensitization campaign on the planned massive digitization of essential registra-

The PS was responding to concerns voiced by the Amnesty International Kenya Director, Iruna, Houghton Director Irungu Houghton who sought assurance that the envisaged rollout will

be preceded by data impact assessment, data protection mechanisms and elaborate public and other stakehold-

ers' involvement.
"We need to make it possible for the public to be aware of what is happening aware of what is happening so that they can participate fully and give feedback so that the exercise that has been mandated by the Pres-ident moves with speed, depth and integrity in re-work to the Data Protection gards to the Data Protection Act," Mr Houghton said. Data Protection Commis-

sioner Immaculate Kassait, who was in attendance, said the country stood to gain from the full implementation of the Data Protection Act as it will mitigate investors' concerns around identity theft and the security of their investments.
