- ii. Ways to bring down the cost of living, eradicate hunger, create jobs, expand the tax base, improve foreign exchange balance and inclusive growth;
- iii. Suggestions on how to strengthen implementation of Government priority programmes under the Bottom-Up Economic Transformation Agenda (BETA) geared towards economic turnaround and inclusive growth;
- iv. Specific ways to accelerate recovery and growth of the private sector and MSMEs;
- v. Tips on how to foster a secure and conducive business environment to promote investment growth, businesses recovery and jobs creation;
- vi. How to integrate the youth and women into accelerating sustainable economic recovery;
- vii. Ways to enhance revenue mobilization and prudently manage public resources; and
- viii. Any other Budget tips or suggestions.
