The Government of Kenya (GoK) has received funding from the World Bank towards the cost of the Financing Locally-Led Climate Action Program (FLLoCA), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the Supply & Delivery of Two (2Nos) Heavy Duty Passenger Vehicles (4X4) LWB 2400-3000cc Diesel.
- 2. The National Treasury and Economic Planning (the Client), through the Program Implementation Unit now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for Supply & Delivery of Two (2Nos) Heavy Duty Passenger Vehicles (4X4) LWB.2400-3000cc Diesel as given below;

Bidders MUST demonstrate that they have successfully completed at least three contracts of similar goods in the past 3 years by providing proof or completion certificates.

Final delivery point for the goods is at the National Treasury and Economic Planning offices located at Kenya Reinsurance Plaza, within 60 days or earlier following the date of contract effectiveness.

3. Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" dated July 2016 and revised in November 2017, August 2018 and

- November 2020 ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
