If not, does the concerned stakeholders possess GIS databases that could be utilized for this study?	A national GIS database does not exist. Certain sector ministries may have GIS mapping of their own projects while others may rely on sector masterplans which the consultants would utilize for the study.
4.	Does a GIS-based land use mapping exist at the national level?	A national GIS database does not exist. However, some sector ministries may have their own GIS mapping for specific projects, while others may use sector masterplans that consultants can reference for the study.
5.	Are existing and potential future development projects mapped in a digital format and if yes, please specify.	There is no single digital document listing the projects.
6.	It is assumed that the energy network includes the oil & gas sector in addition to the power. Please confirm.	We confirm that the energy network encompasses both the oil and gas sector as well as power.

Our understanding is that the water supply scope includes storage reservoirs and the related upstream works such as transmission lines and treatment works but the water distribution networks from the reservoirs to the houses are excluded. Please confirm.	Yes, the water supply scope encompasses storage reservoirs and related upstream works such as transmission lines and treatment facilities, but it excludes water distribution networks from the reservoirs to individual homes.
10.	Our understanding is that the sewage system scope is limited to the main transmission lines and sewage treatment plants. Please confirm.	Yes, the scope of the sewage system is confined to the main transmission lines and sewage treatment plants
11.	Please advise if storm water drainage systems are included in the scope of work. If yes please clarify the scope of work.	Storm water drainage should be considered and discussed to the extent that there is available data from earlier masterplans and/or independent studies/reports.
12.	Please confirm that the irrigation system is not included in the scope.	Yes, the irrigation system is outside the scope.
13.	The terms of reference only provides for the overall duration of the assignment. There is no information relating to the indicative time input in man-months for the key staff. Time input for key staff is a primary consideration in determining the cost of the financial proposal, and consequently	The indicative input in man-months is driven by the approach/methodology proposed. As such, it is for the bidder to estimate the time allocation per consultant proposed.

The three preferred currencies are Kenyan Shilling (Ksh), United States Dollar (USD), and Euro. The official source of the selling exchange rate is: Central Bank of Kenya. Refer to Clause 26.1 of the ITT-Page 32 of the bid document.
15	Eligibility	Consulting firms currently engaged in more than two active projects with the National Treasury and Economic Planning are ineligible to participate.
16	We hereby request for a three weeks extension of the submission deadline.	The tender closing date has been rescheduled from 16th April, 2024 to 03 rd May, 2024 at 11:00 AM.
